Hello students and parents/caregivers,

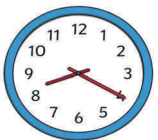

School Start - 8:20 am

School starts at 8:20 a.m. We ask that parents and caregivers do their best to arrive as close to our start time as possible so that we can do our entry physical distancing/hand washing/health and safety procedures all at once with our students.



If you are arriving late, please have your child knock on the front door. A staff member will assist them.

Weather

Please make sure your child is dressed for the weather. Students need to be prepared to go outside if it is sunny or raining for outdoor learning, recess and lunch. Pack an umbrella, sunscreen, jacket and hat to be prepared for anything.

Remote Learning

For those students at home, remote learning will be sent out on Wednesdays, as teachers are teaching in-class on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday. Just a reminder that the remote learning teachers provide will be significantly reduced due to their return to in-class instruction. You can provide at-home learning with daily reading, writing (journal, letters to relatives), math (baking, telling time, making change/money, addition/subtraction/multiplication/division facts), and physical outdoor activities.

Thursday, June 25 – Student Spotlight Day: Show us a picture of you doing your favourite sport, hobby, or activity!

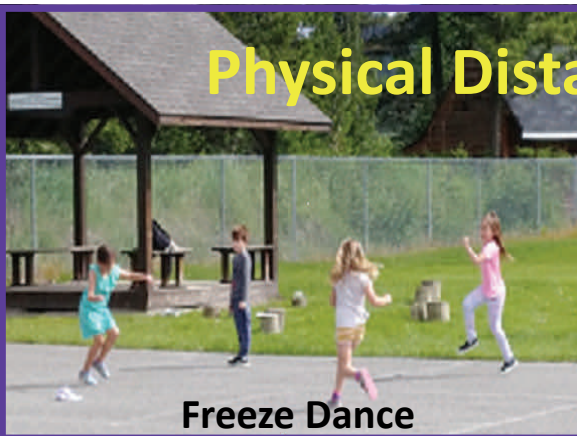


Water Bottles
